#### **SMISBY**

Its church looks over the housetops into Leicestershire and has monuments to the Kendall's who lived at the Old Hall which is now a farmhouse near to the church.

The first building on the site was a Chapel of Ease which was built by the Monks from Repton in 1068 and this now forms the South aisle. The nave and chancel were added by Joanne Comyn. She married William Shepey in 1300 and became owner of Smisby and its Manor when he died.

She died in 1350 and her memorial is next to the font. The tower was added in the 15th century and contains two bells which are inscribed "God save the King 1617" (Charles I) and "God save King Charles the Second 1662"

The font is 14th century in date and of octagonal design. It was situated, originally under the first arch but was moved to its present position in the 1890's when the church was restored, and it was set on a new base to match its design. At this time the floor was raised so that the stone heating channels could be put under the floor which almost covered the pillar bases.

In the 1960's the old organ was removed and a new one was built under the tower. A side altar was placed where the first alter had been and the broken piscina was restored. The side alter was dedicated to Dr. Mark Baker, the village's doctor, who gave his life trying to save two men trapped down a well.

There are three monuments in its church, of which one has not been without adventure in its six centuries. Once on a raised tomb, it was long hidden under the pews, but it was saved from this humility and set against the wall. It is an alabaster stone sculptured with the figure of a woman in a long mantle with her hands clasped on her breast. She was Joan Comyn, who died in 1350 and was heiress of the Lord of the Manor. Her face is much worn and one of her shields is gone, but the heiress found under the pews was for long the most important Lady of Smisby. For it was through marrying her descendant that the Kendalls came to the Hall

The memorial in the south aisle is that of William Kendall, great, great, grandson of Joanne Comyn and his wife Ann. His portrait was engraved in stone when he died in 1500. He is worn away but his wife can still be seen. On the outside buttress of the south aisle is Hastings ragged sleeve, probably placed there after William's two brothers, Richard and Thomas, who were killed at Bosworth in 1485.

The third memorial is by the side of the main altar and is that of Henry Kendall, great grandson to William, and his wife Elizabeth. He is seen kneeling with his wife on their great monument with their 16 children. With two sons and one daughter in shrouds. The eldest son Henry sold the Manor of Smisby to the Crewes of Calke Abbey in 1660.

The linen-fold panelling behind the main altar originally came from Ashby Castle and was brought to Smisby in the 1850's.

The squint or hagioscope was widened in the 1890's to give a view of the alter from the South aisle


The carved wooden War Memorial on the South wall is the work of a Smisby craftsman, William Bailey.

The windows are of varying dates and types. The three light East window in the chancel is an example of decorated work, about 1350, but the centre was filled with masonry before 1850. The East window behind the side altar is an early English Lancet window. The other windows are of a much later date.

The village still keeps its old lock-up. A tiny octagonal building with a studded door and a spire like roof.

Also it is believed that here, in the fields behind the school, was fought the famous tournament described by Scott in Ivanhoe, less than two miles from the castle round which some of the scenes in the story were laid.
